Title history: EL 27742 granted 09/07/2015 and cancelled 18/08/2016

Location, physiography and access: EL 27742 is located on the western side of the NT. Access from Darwin, via the Stuart and Victoria highways. Station roads and bush tracks provided access to EL 27742. Access to the EL area via the best maintained roads was denied by local Aboriginals and station owners/management. Alternative routes via old bush tracks proved to be torturous and time consuming due their poor condition.

Geology Setting: EL 27742 was located within the Kalkarindji Provence and the Wolf Basin.

Exploration/Mining History: N/A

Exploration Rationale: The intent was to conduct a preliminary ground survey and take chip samples from prospective areas after recording their locations via GPS. In addition, it was thought possible that native cooper nuggets may exist which could be located with a metal detector.

Work Completed: No on the ground due to difficulty of gaining access to the site.

Results: None to report



Conclusions/Recommendations: The area may have potential but the access issues make the areas unattractive for the small private operator.
