Marketing of the Rose Quartz we have been extracting from this site has been slow. There are still substantial quantities on hand which has meant that further extraction has been unnecessary. There has been some recovery of a small quantity of surface material which radiation from the sun seems to have naturally heat treated making it much clearer, however, the density of the rose colour is not as good in the surface material.
