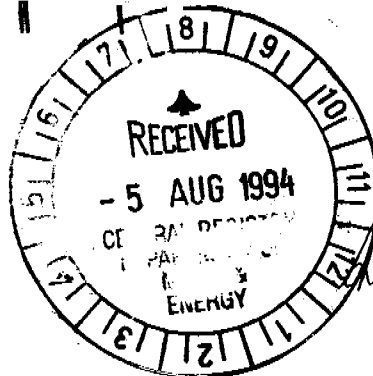

EXPLORATION LICENCE 8190 - BERNARD J. THYNNE 50%
& ROBERT L. MURCOTT 50%.

I wish to report that NO exploration activity of any kind took place on the licence (8190) area, of which expired on the 11th July 1994. The reason being is that Mr Murcott suffered a serious knee injury around the time of the planned exploration. It was planned that Mr Murcott was to drive from Victoria to the Northern Territory, and carry out the works as stipulated. I was to stay in Melbourne to finance the operation, and co-ordinate any eventuating activities. The injury to Mr Murcott was serious, which prevented him from any participation. The injury

to Mr Murcott was unforeseen. Details of the incident which led to the injury have been lodged with the Albany Police, and a medical examination done by Dr Twomey of Albany, New South Wales. I understand a knee re-construction is required.

I regret not having to fulfil the requirements of the licence, and I ask you to consider this reason compassionately. Enclosed is a cheque for £50.00, for the fee required. I thank you very much for your co-operation.
