- Qs Active stream-bed silt/clay, gravel, sand, silt.
- Qf Black soil, organic detritus, sediment.
- Qg Overbank sand and deposits adjacent to creek, sand bars.
- Qh Talus from local sources, sandstone boulder platforms.
- Qi Reddish-brown sand, gray sandy silt on sandstone.
- Qj Reddish-brown, ferruginous, nodular to massive.
- Qk Reddish-brown surface, comprising thin sandy silt, ferruginous sandstone, and fragments on sandstone boulders.
- Ql Unfossiliferous medium to coarse grained massive cross-bedded (gray) quartz sandstone, rare to show bedding, quartz pebbles.
- Qm Medium grained massive to laminated cross-bedded (gray) quartz sandstone with thin quartz pebble conglomerate at base, including bedding quartz pebbles throughout, decreasing upward.
- Qn Fine grained (red-brown) ferruginous quartz sandstone, thin upper layer of shaly clay rip-up clasts.
- Qo Fine - medium grained massive (gray) cross-bedded (gray to purple-gray) quartz sandstone.
- Qp Limestone capping Chert Creek.
- Qq Medium grained massive (gray) quartz sandstone.
- Qr Fine grained thin bedded to laminated (purple) mudstone and cross-bedded (pink) quartz sandstone.
- Qs Medium to fine grained massive (ferruginous) shaly (dark gray) quartz sandstone.
- Qt Fine grained thin bedded cross-bedded (brown) ripple marked orange-pink quartz sandstone.
