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General; Work carried out on the Lease area last year consisted of; Gridding of relevant features of the Lease area; Taking Samples of reef outcrops, (other than the main 2 reefs); Improving Access from the Mount Wells - Pine Creek Road turn off, by improving the crossing of the creek which flows from the Union Reefs area.

; Establishing access to the Lease from the West, from the Stuart Hwy - Springhill Road via a good crossing on the McEntay River, and a good crossing on the granite sourced creek just East of the Stuart Hwy - Spring Hill road turn off.

Details: A diagram showing features on the Lease is included in this report. I had planned to determine the amount and also relevant size of (Width and length) outcroppings of obviously mineralized rocks/smaller reefs, however on further appraisal, it seems these for the major reef are of very insignificant extent. There is a lot of Quartz rock outcropping in the vicinity of the top of the Hill, along which the reef runs, and also, to the East of this area, there is some mineralized reef outcroppings.

The samples taken show iron oxides etc, and though no assays were done due to the limited extent of these outcroppings, some assays may be warranted on these in the vicinity of the area near the top of the Hill. As stated above, this area has a lot of Quartz and possibly should be further appraised to determine whether this is associated with the main 'N° 1' reef (on which the 2 shafts were sunk further along) which to some extent seems independent in origin.

Access; as outlined above this has been established from the west of the Lease, via the St Hwy - Spring Hill road. This access is suitable for four wheel drive vehicles only, as is that from the East and South as well.

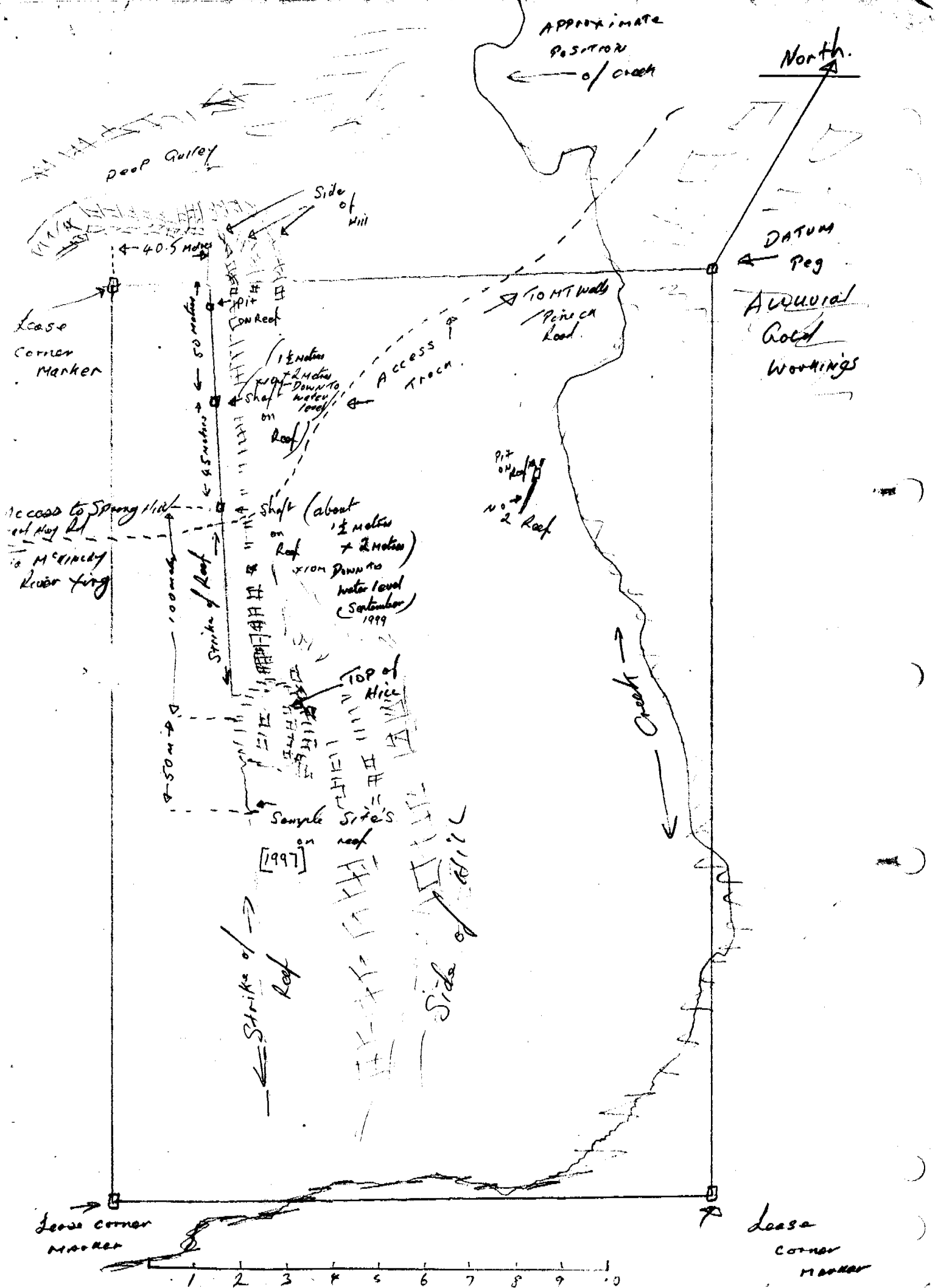
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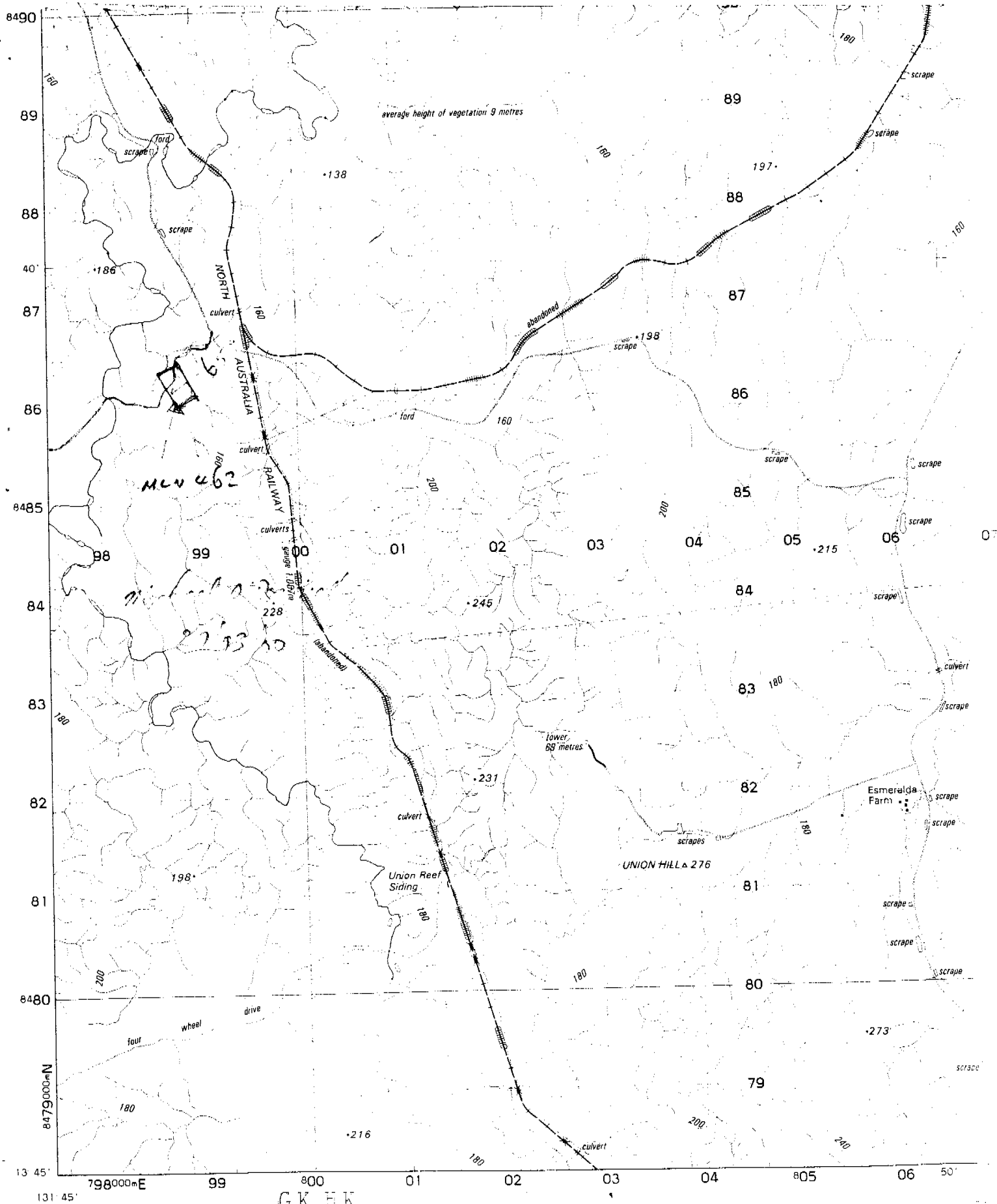

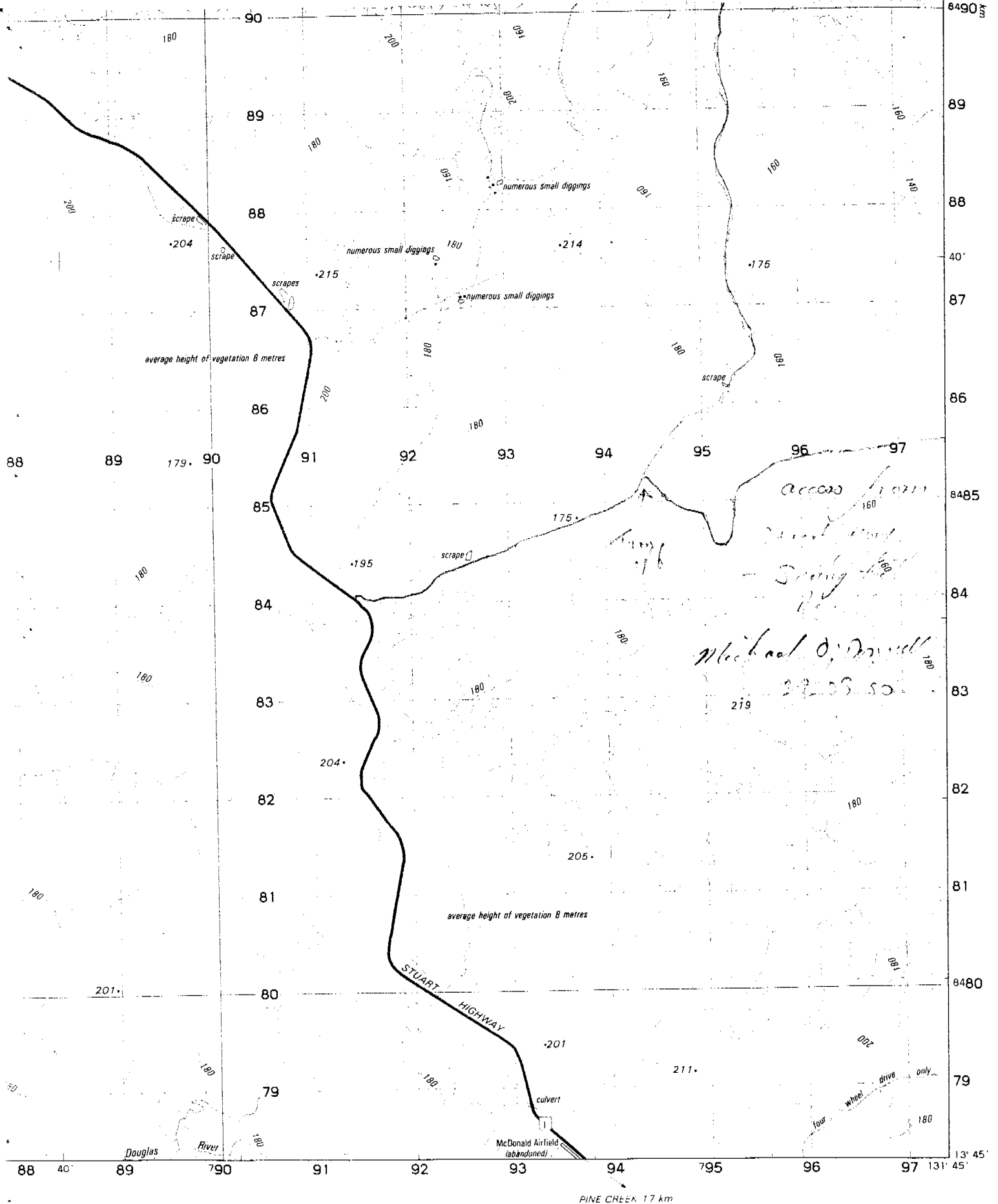


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WATERCOURSE GUIDE
