

A NewTEM survey was flown over the Tanami Mine Sequence from the 28th of July and took 10 days to complete. The area covered 10km by 38km, with 7km lines at 200m line spacing. The objective of the survey was to map out the sulphides along the Tanami Mine Sequence, and to see if any structures can be mapped. Additional to the main survey, regional lines are being decided on to test the ability of the system to determine depth of cover.

The seismic survey being run by Geoscience Australia (GA) ran from the 19th of May to the ____ in the Tanami region. With Newmont giving monetary support, we will be able to obtain the raw data and also the processed GA data. We are considering attaining the services of someone at Curtin University (Perth) to process the raw data for us on the assumption that GA will be concentrating on the deep structures, whereas we wish to focus on the shallower.

A gravity survey was completed in the McFarlane's area by Fugro Ground. It began on the _____ and finished 27th of October. There were 2380 stations at 1km spacing. The survey was carried out to get a better understanding of the large structures in the area, especially the intrusions.
