A.P. 3428 - ASARCO (A ustralia) Pty. Ltd. SOUTHERN CROSS 2 Prospect PROGRESS REPORT FOR MAY, 1972

A further period of fieldwork within the A.P. commenced during this month. At this stage, it is anticipated that investigations will be complete during mid-June.

Geological reconnaissance has failed to indicate rock units for follow up investigations. Most emphasis has been given to metamorphosed carbonate rock types, but no evidence of metallic mineralization of potential size and grade to justify additional detailed work has been found.

Stream sediment sampling within the A.P. has been completed. 373 samples were collected and analysed for Cu, Pb, Zn, Ni. In addition, 164 of this number were analysed for Co and Mo. This work, together with geologic traversing and prospecting of the A.P. area, has not led to the discovery of significant base or precious metal mineralization.

Approximately one hour of aerial reconnaissance was also flown as a final check upon the ground investigations.

Results are now being compiled and maps prepared to accompany the final report of the company's work upon A.P. 3428.
