

Site Lithologies EL26900



KS2 – Fine-grained laminated relict-fossil buff limestone. “Fossil” occurrences very common throughout, but only in regard to ferruginised relict holes where the “assumed” biota used to be. Grain size does not appear to vary much, although units do weather differentially. Minor recrystallisation only.



KS3 – This site records a wide range of limestone-associated strata over a stratigraphic thickness of approximately 3-4 m. Generally, the lithology is represented by fine-laminated buff limestone with or without “fossil” layers and “nodule” layers.



KS4 – Nodular, but laminated and stromatolitic (?) limestone. Sample was collected from a laminated section of the rock, and comprises fine, buff-coloured limestone with some evidence of relict fossil (?) spaces.
