#### ı. PURPOSE

To describe the process of quarrying, transporting and processing gypsum for use in the Cement Manufacturing Process at Quarantine Island-Grinding Plant.

#### 2. **DEFINITIONS**

None

#### 3. **PROCEDURE**

### 3.1 Quarrying

All materials extracted from the leases at Alexandria Station must be in accordance with the plan provided by Northern Cement Ltd., which is developed on a yearly basis before June. This plan will describe the method, quantity, areas to be quarried and stockpile locations. All quarrying operations must comply with the NT Mine Management Act and Regulations and the Mining Act. A close liaison must be maintained with Alexandria Station Management and Staff.

#### 3.2 Lease Maintenance

An inspection of all the mineral claims must take place at least once per year to ensure all datums, corner posts, boundary posts and directional trenches are correctly placed. During these visits any issues between Northern Cement Ltd. and Alexandria Station regarding the operations can be discussed.

#### 3.3 Caterpillar Loader

The 920 Caterpillar loader used to load trucks for transportation of gypsum to either Mataranka or Darwin is permanently stationed at Alexandria Station and is utilised by the Station when required. In return, fuelling, minor maintenance and servicing of the loader is carried out by the Station Staff.

#### **Aboriginal Sacred Sites** 3.4

A sacred site exists in the creek bed area near the pit. All personnel should be made aware of it's location and not drive any machinery or vehicles into the area. See attached map for location.

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## 3.5 Transportation

Prior to commencement of operations each year, the transport operators shall be instructed as to which material is to be loaded, it's destination and any other instructions that may be required.

## 3.6 Weighing & Documentation

All loads must be weighed at Mataranka and the weights recorded on the Gypsum Weigh Sheet (MF002) and in the docket book marked Gypsum, clearly identifying whether the load is incoming (to Mataranka from Alexandria Station) or outgoing (from Mataranka to Darwin). The exact location for delivery, the transport docket number and drivers signature shall be clearly marked.

## 3.7 Mataranka to Darwin

If the gypsum is erushed at Mataranka, deliveries will be directly to Quarantine Island Plant or Tivendale Road. If uncrushed, the Lime Plant Manager or Cement Plant Supervisor will specify a delivery point.

## 3.8 Crushing

All gypsum is to be crushed to-75mm prior to delivery to Quarantine Island
