## Summary of Activities - Year One

In the first year of tenure, no on-ground work was undertaken on EL 23925. However, as part of the Mount Doreen Project, EL 23925 was included in a project review and numerous targets have been identified within the tenement. Of greatest interest is the northwest continuation of the Mount Hardy Cu-Au structural corridor and some linear magnetic highs. EL 23925 has yet to be included in the Mount Doreen Indigenous Land Use Agreement.

## Proposed Program and Budget - Year Two

In the second year of tenure, reconnaissance surface sampling and mapping is planned over the most prospective parts of EL 23925. This will include rockchip, lag and soil sampling across the Mount Hardy structural corridor and a number of identified magnetic anomalies. If suitably anomalous results are forthcoming, a RAB drilling programme will follow. It is hoped that access to EL 23925 will be forthcoming by its inclusion into the Mount Doreen Indigenous Land Use Agreement.
