Re: Annual Report Year Ended 11 September, 2005 Exploration Retention Licence 116 (Mt Porter) Arafura Resources NL

Activity on the area of ERL 116 during the past year was restricted to the area under application for ML 23839 for which a Right To Occupy was issued by your Department in February, 2005.

Operations conducted in the past 12 months include:

- Maintenance of existing access tracks to and across the project area.
- Completion of RTN process and execution of Native Title Compensation Agreement with registered Native Title Claimants in December, 2004.
- Survey of the boundary of ML 23839 and submission of survey to The Department of Planning and Infrastructure on 9 September, 2005.
- Appointment of MBS Environmental to coordinate the Public Environmental Report process.
- Conduct of surveys required for PER as per Guidelines issued by the Office of Environment and Heritage in October, 2004, including:
 - d Mount Porter gold mine site, Pine Creek, NT: Archaeological Survey by R G Gunn
 - o Environmental Survey of Landscape, Flora and Fauna of the Proposed Mt Porter Project Area (ML 23839) by Low Ecological Services Pty Ltd
 - o Mount Porter Wastes Characterisation and ARD Management by MBS Environmental

Information gathered to date in relation to the PER is currently still in draft form and will be submitted formally when all other PER-related investigations are completed. This includes groundwater investigation estimated to cost in excess of \$200,000 which will only be conducted after the near-by Union Reef mill is recommissioned.

No work is planned in the next 12 months for that part of the ERL which remains surrounding ML 23839.
