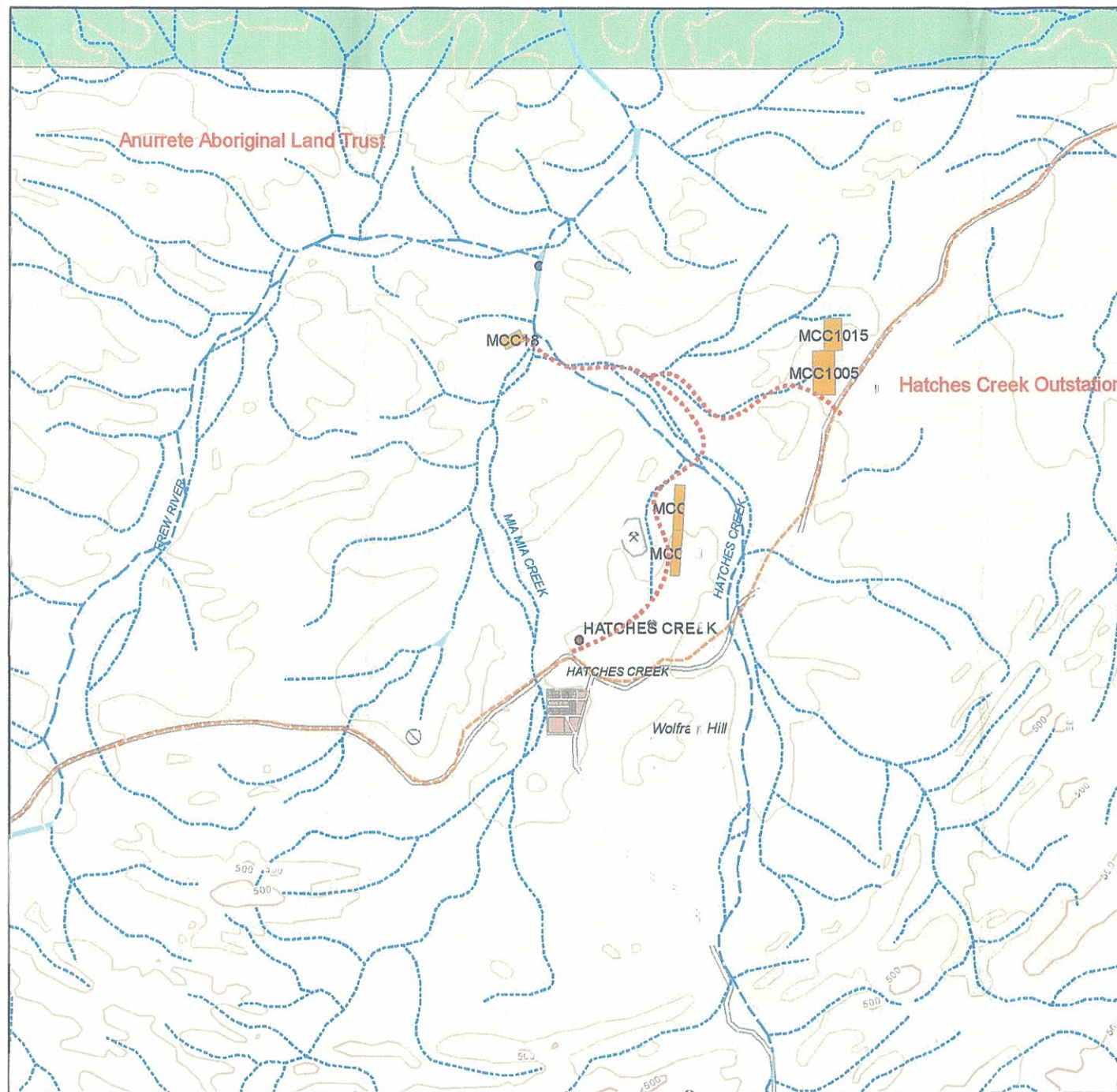

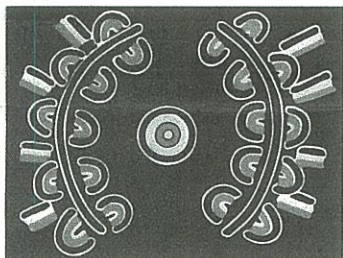

Could you please sign the agreement and return it either by mail to Alice Springs or to the Central Land Council Office in Tennant Creek at your earliest convenience. The signed agreement will enable you to access your tenements under the terms of the Agreement.

I would appreciate if you could please forward me a copy of your Mine Management Plan for the tenements so that traditional Aboriginal owners may be kept informed of activities. Questions have been raised by traditional Aboriginal owners regarding activities on the MCCs (a loader was on site and ground clearance has occurred). *MCC 1015 + MCC 1005 NOT ME*
