INTRODUCTION

Olympia Resources Ltd has concentrated this year on conducting marketing studies on the Aturga abrasive deposit, identifying water for the project and conducting a regional assessment of tenements east of the Aturga deposit.

The main thrust of the years work has been completing a revised feasibility study on the Aturga deposit with a lower production level and more selective grading of garnet that resulted from the marketing study completed by Mr Robert Brand on the Australian abrasive requirements. Further resource level drilling was completed on the coarse grained garnet portion of the Aturga deposit. The study has demonstrated that the project is feasible and the Company has moved toward financing. Eleven water bores were drilled on EL24360 in the continuing studies on a potential source of water in the Ambalindum Sandstone. Pump testing of these bore is continuing. The eastern tenements E23087-23090 have had reconnaissance drilling completed on them during this year and a recommendation has been made to abandon heavy mineral sand exploration on these tenements. Reconnaissance drilling was also completed on EL24360 and EL10372 on areas that access has been approved by the CLC. Reports associated with these studies have been appended to this report.

Table 1 summarises the exploration tenure of Olympia Resources Ltd .

It is noted that expenditure for the year is less than the proposed covenant; however the \$120,000 covenant for EL25098-25099, EL24378 and EL24641 should be removed as we only gained access to these tenements in September and October of 2006. Of the tenements we had access the covenant was \$294,000, compared to \$353,878 actually spent. There has been some redistribution of expenditure attributed to continuing exploration for water and studies associated with the feasibility study on the Aturga minesite.

No covenant allowance has been made for the intended plant building at Aturga where the capital cost is expected to be to be in the vicinity of \$9million.

This Exploration Licence surrounds the Mining Lease ML23868 and the work this year has been concentrated on the Mining Lease. In 2006 further drilling and pitting was completed to provide material for bulk testing associated with the feasibility study Olympia. Metallurgical testwork continues. The material is currently being processed in Perth and the results will be reported in the Annual Report for 2008.

This tenement was granted on 15th September 2006. Reconnaissance traverses of air-core drilling were completed on the floodplain on the Plenty River and test work is proceeding on those samples. This tenement covers the proposed bore field for the Aturga Minesite and during this time 11 air-core bores have been drilled prospecting for water and three monitor bores have been drilled. There is on going pump tests on these bores.
