EL 26055: This licence is located upon pastoral land (Dalmore Downs Stations) in the Barkly District of the Northern Territory.




Figure 1 Location Map

#### **Mineral Tenure:**

The exploration licences were granted to Fertoz Ltd in accordance with the *Mining Act* on 5/09/2008.

The licences were purchased by Mandarin Mining Pty Ltd in October 2013.

This is the Sixth Annual Technical Report which covers activities in the period 5/09/2013 to 4/09/2014. At the end of the sixth year of tenure the licences underwent a mandatory reduction, consequently the following areas were relinquished from the licences.

EL 26054: 104 subblocks EL 26055: 115 subblocks

This leaves the area retained by each licence at renewal:

At this time renewals for both licences have been lodged with the Department of Mines and Energy.




Figure 2 ELs 26054 and 26055 before relinquishment




Figure 3 ELs 26054 and 26055 after relinquishment
