Purpose for which Titles are held	Essentially to mine the tailings from the former alluvial operator Mentana Minerals for the purpose of extracting stone/gold.
Title History	<p>This title was worked in the mid 1980's by Metana Minerals. An alluvial operation was running for approximately 4 years during which time it is estimated 800,000 to 1,000,000 metres of alluvial dirt was mined from the pre-existing workings (1880's) using heavy minerals separation plant. During this period of mining no hazardous chemicals were in use and as a result there is no toxic waste present. No work has been undertaken since the above period. These titles were held by Northern Gold in the 1980's then a succession of other title holders, most recently the title holder being Crocodile Gold. Dale Page purchased these titles from Crocodile Gold in December 2014.</p> <p>The historic disturbed areas on this title consist of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Extraction pit that is now the largest water dam on title</li> <li>• Secondary extraction pit that is now a water dam – this one located closer to the Stuart Highway</li> <li>• Tailing Dam</li> <li>• Tailing Stockpile</li> <li>• Gate at entrance from the Stuart Highway for the main road running through the title that provides access to the north</li> <li>• Other smaller access tracks</li> </ul>
Reason for Nil Activity	<p>During this period Dale Page was working at the Redhill Alluvial Project until July 2016. In the months that followed the Redhill Alluvial Project was cleared of Camp, Equipment, Processing Plant, etc in preparation for cessation of activity.</p> <p>The Camp, Processing Plant, Plant Machinery &amp; Equipment from the Redhill Alluvial Project site has been relocated to the Bridge Creek Project site. To date no mining activity has taken place.</p>
Commencement of Activity	Expected to commence possibly in May/June 2017 at the earliest.
Nature of that Activity	The first stage of mining activity will involve mining the tailings from the former alluvial operator Mentana Minerals. These activities will take a minimum of 12 months and possibly up to 48 months maximum. Overall 90% of material processed on site will be sourced from the old tailings stockpile on site. The remaining 10% of material to be processed will come from new exploration pits nearby which are yet to be determined (exploration yet to take place). All exploration work will be confined to

	MLN 1060 and all exploration work will be by sampling only. There will be no drilling or costeaning.
