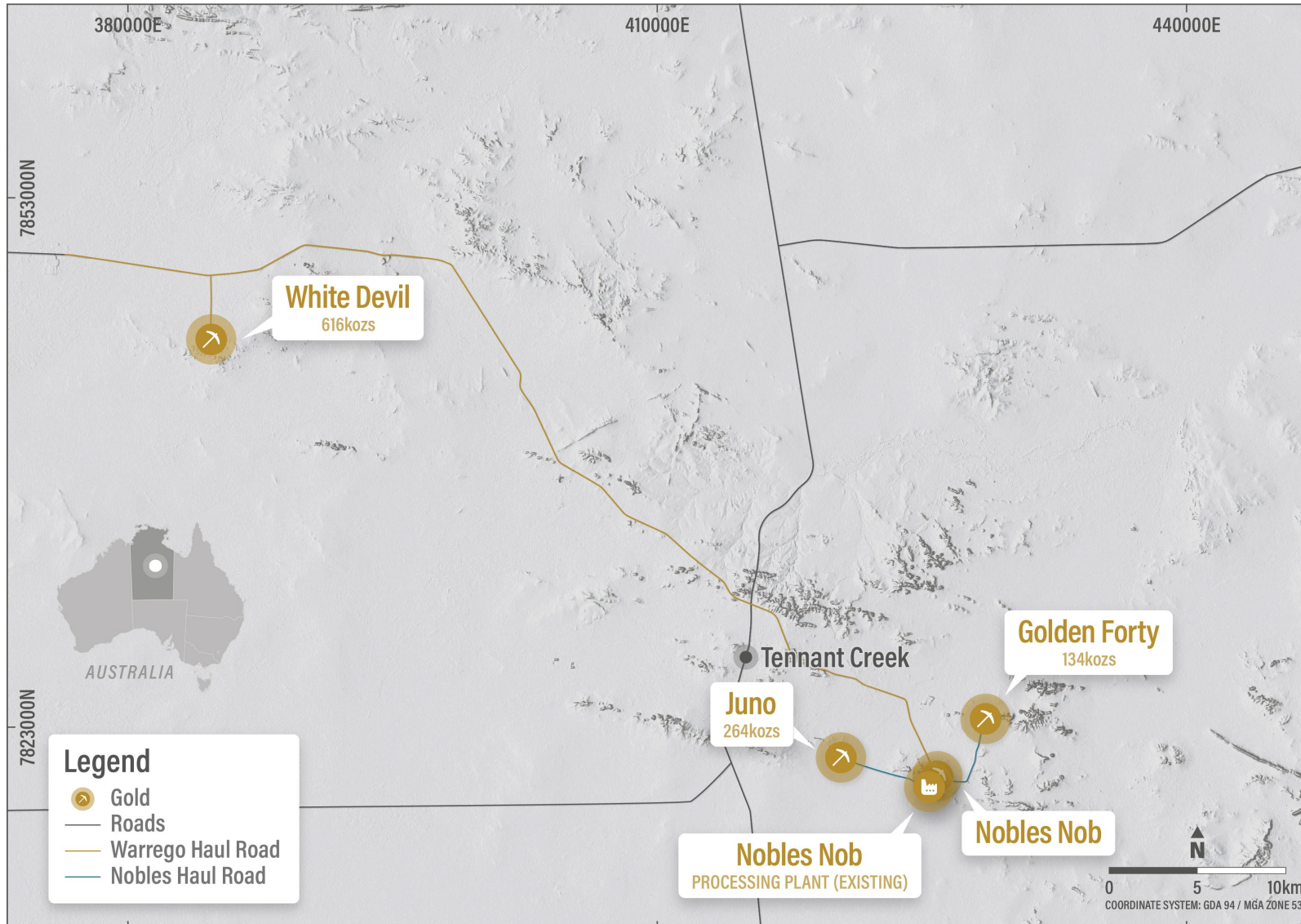

Transitioning to open pit sources in 2026

- Production expanding to 50+kozs

Development of longer life deposits – White Devil, Juno, Golden 40

- Steady growth up to 100kozs gold

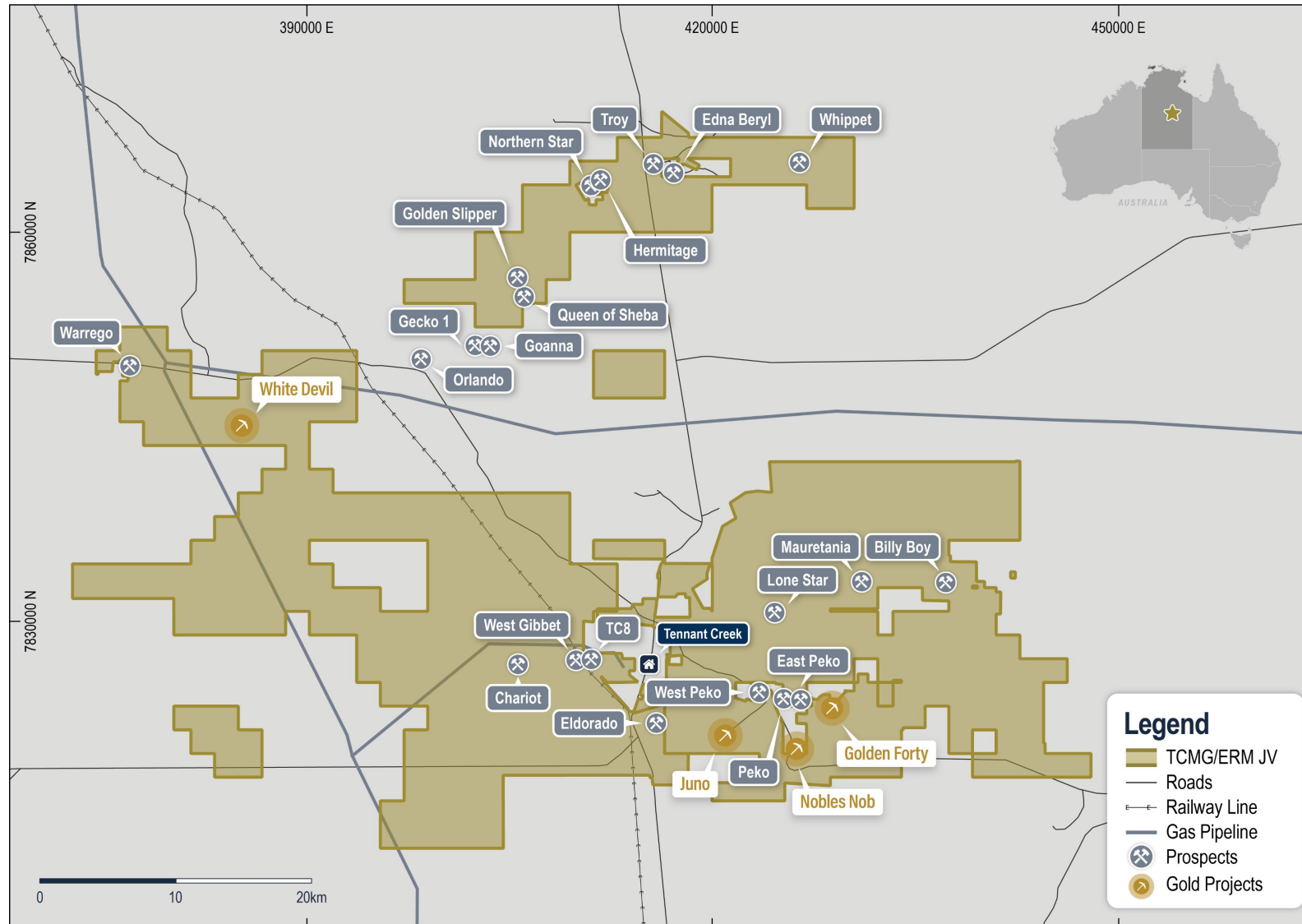

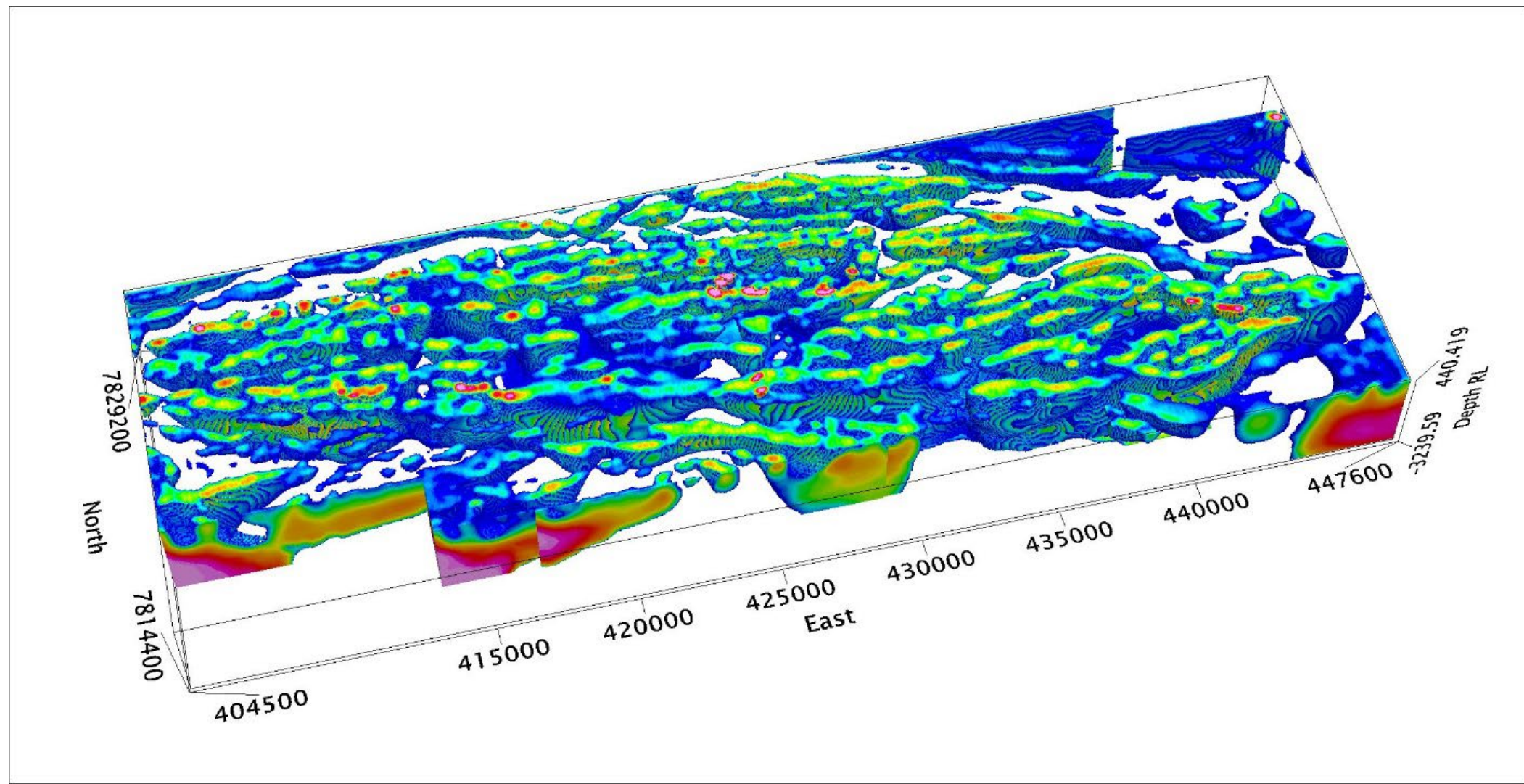

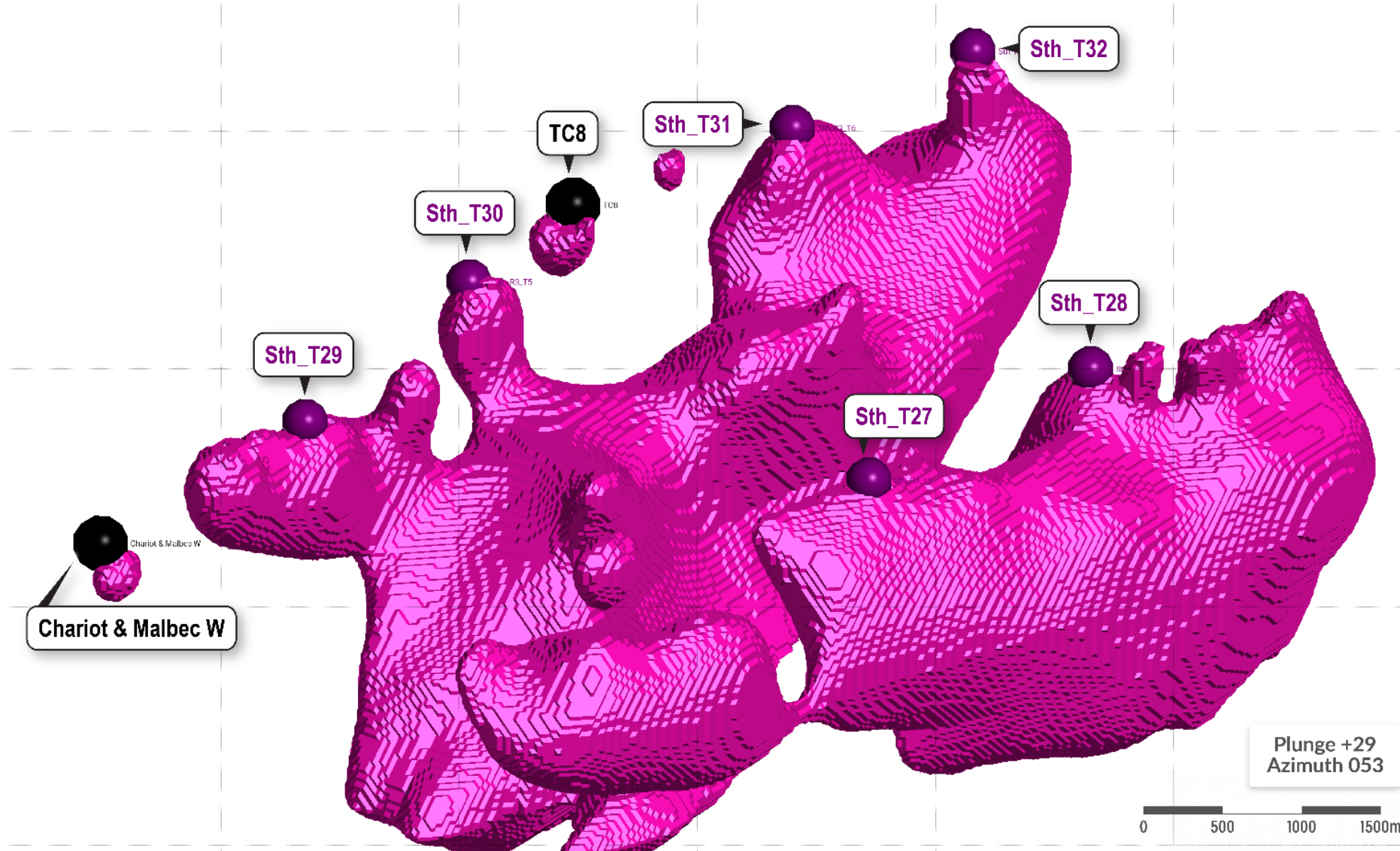
EXPLORATION PORTFOLIO – WHERE TO START



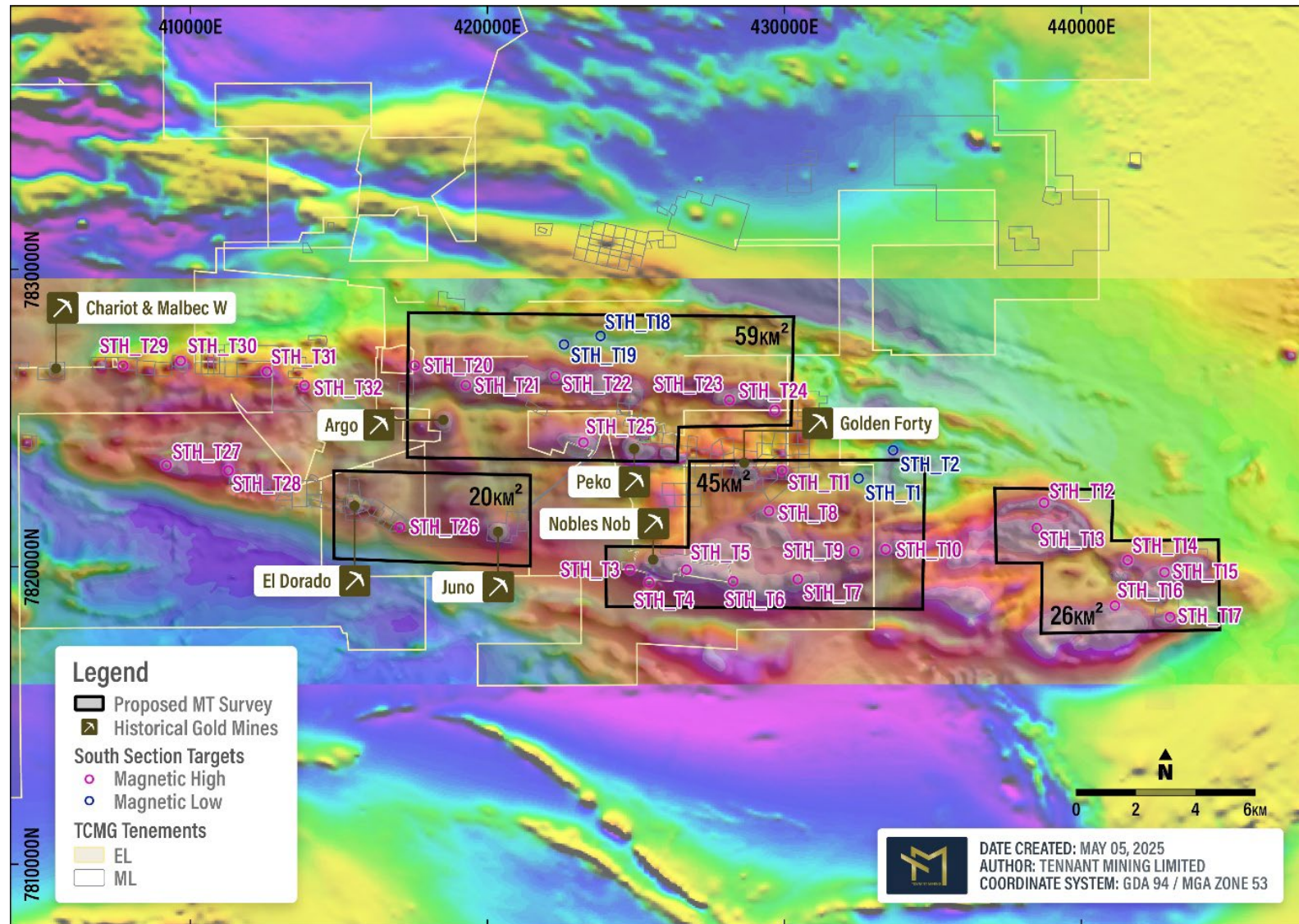
EXPLORATION PORTFOLIO – NEW MVI MODEL COMPLETED

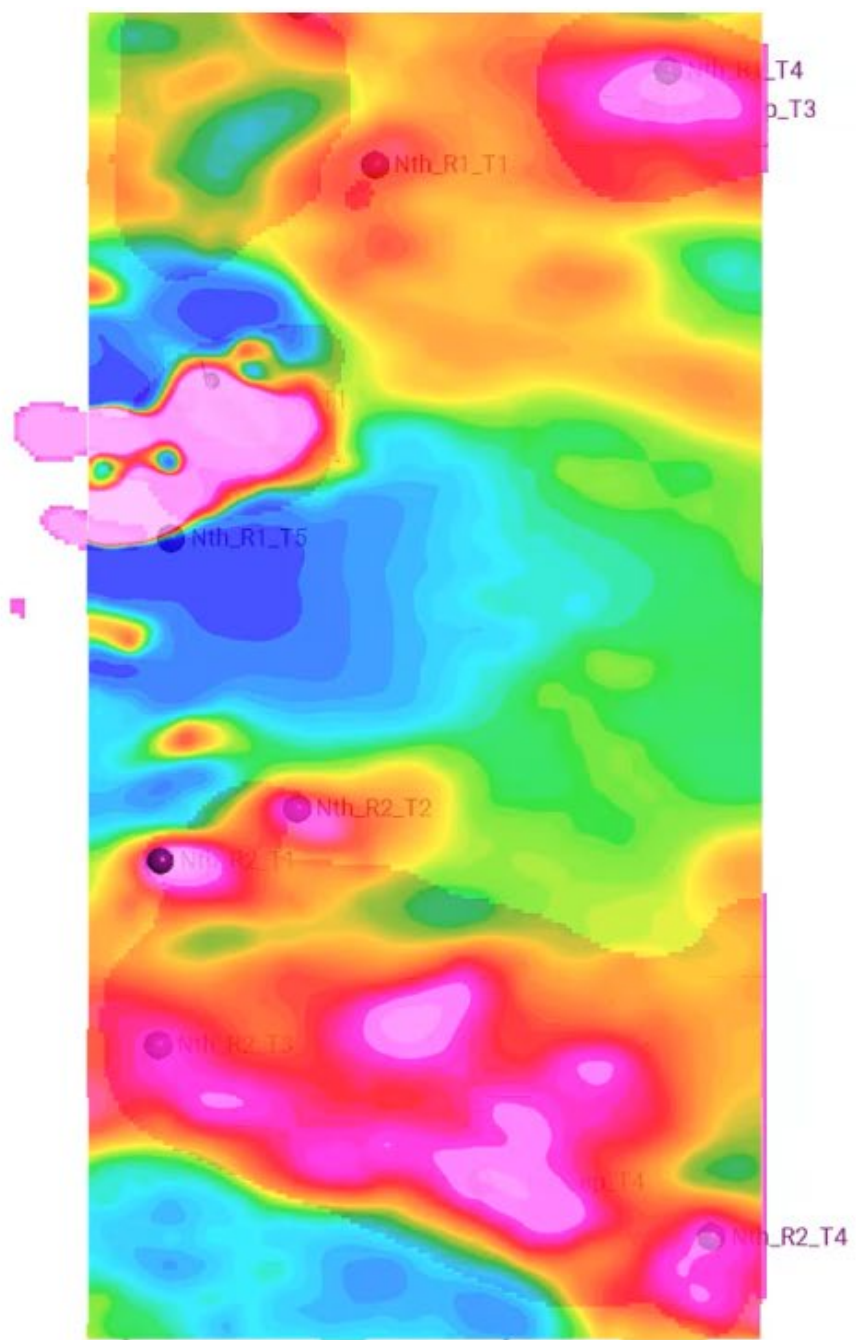


NEW METHODS
